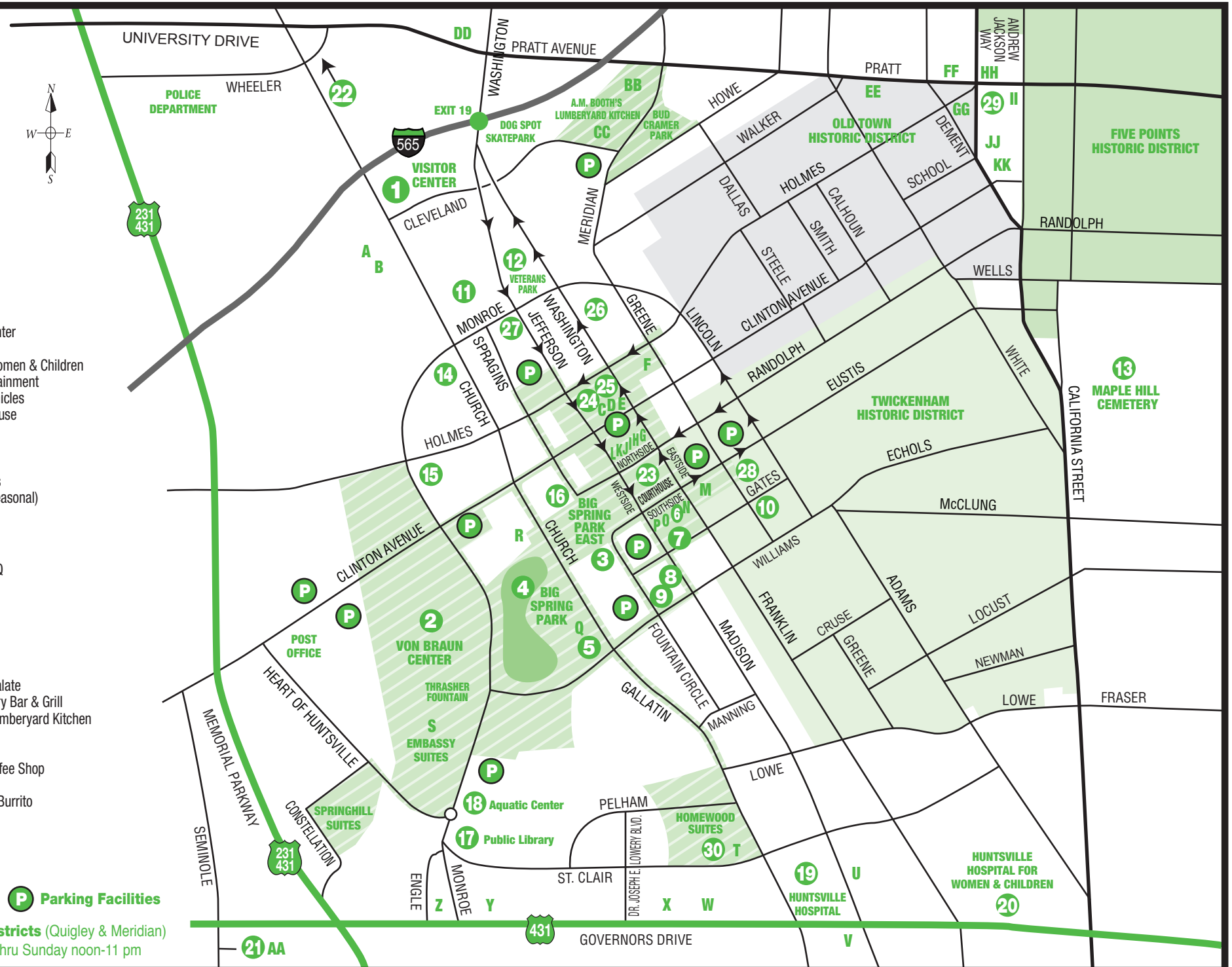

- 1 VISITOR CENTER** - For complete information on the area and clues for the Lucky Duck and Trains on Main Scavenger Hunts, go to the **Huntsville/Madison County Visitor Center**. Open every day except major holidays. 256-533-5723 • 500 Church Street NW • huntsville.org
- 2 VON BRAUN CENTER** - The center hosts hundreds of meetings, exhibitions and cultural performances each year. 256-533-1953 • 700 Monroe Street • vonbrauncenter.com
- 3 CITY HALL** - 308 Fountain Circle • 256-535-2489 • huntsvilleal.gov
- 4 BIG SPRING INTERNATIONAL PARK** - The landscaped park bisected by waters from the Big Spring lies between the Von Braun Center and the Courthouse Square.
- 5 HUNTSVILLE MUSEUM OF ART** - Galleries display pieces from the permanent collection as well as touring exhibitions. Visit the museum shop off the lobby. 256-535-4350 • 300 Church Street SW • hsvmuseum.org
- 6 HARRISON BROTHERS HARDWARE** - Established in 1879 and owned by the non-profit Historic Huntsville Foundation. The state's oldest hardware store and popular gift store. 256-536-3631 • 124 Southside Square • harrisonbrothershardware.com
- 7 ALABAMA CONSTITUTION VILLAGE** - The living-history village commemorates the writing of Alabama's first constitution on this site. Costumed guides stroll through period rooms. 256-535-6564 • 109 Gates Avenue • earlyworks.com
- 8 EARLYWORKS CHILDREN'S MUSEUM** - This innovative, hands-on history experience features Alabama buildings, a storytelling tree and a talking clock. 256-564-8100 • 404 Madison Street • earlyworks.com
- 9 BICENTENNIAL PARK** - An interactive fountain for the young and young at heart to romp in, bench seating, bronze statues, and a pavilion. 315 Fountain Circle
- 10 THE WEEDEN HOUSE** - Built in 1819, this is the oldest building in Alabama open to the public. For over a century, the Federal structure was home to the Weeden family. 256-536-7718 • 300 Gates Avenue • weedenhousemuseum.com
- 11 HISTORIC HUNTSVILLE DEPOT** - The three-story brick depot was built in 1860 and captured by Union forces in 1862, during the Civil War. Grounds are open to the public daily. 256-564-8100 • 320 Church Street NW • earlyworks.com
- 12 HUNTSVILLE VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK** - Sparkling fountains provide the hub of a semi-circular design that pays homage to America's wartime efforts. 200 Monroe Street NW • huntsvilleveteransmemorial.org
- 13 MAPLE HILL CEMETERY** - Founded in 1818, Maple Hill is one of Alabama's oldest and most beautiful cemeteries and borders the Twickenham Historic District. The name connotes the scores of maple trees which each October color the "burial ground."
