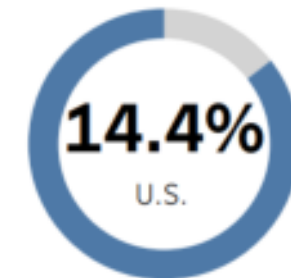
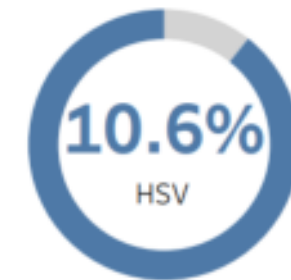


Summary:

Unemployment Rate April 2020



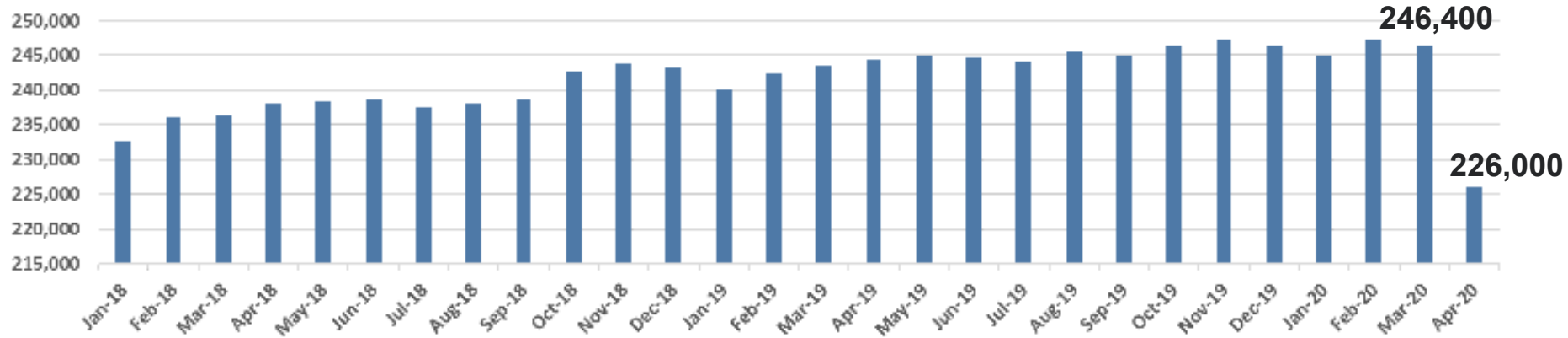
U.S. Preliminary Unemployment

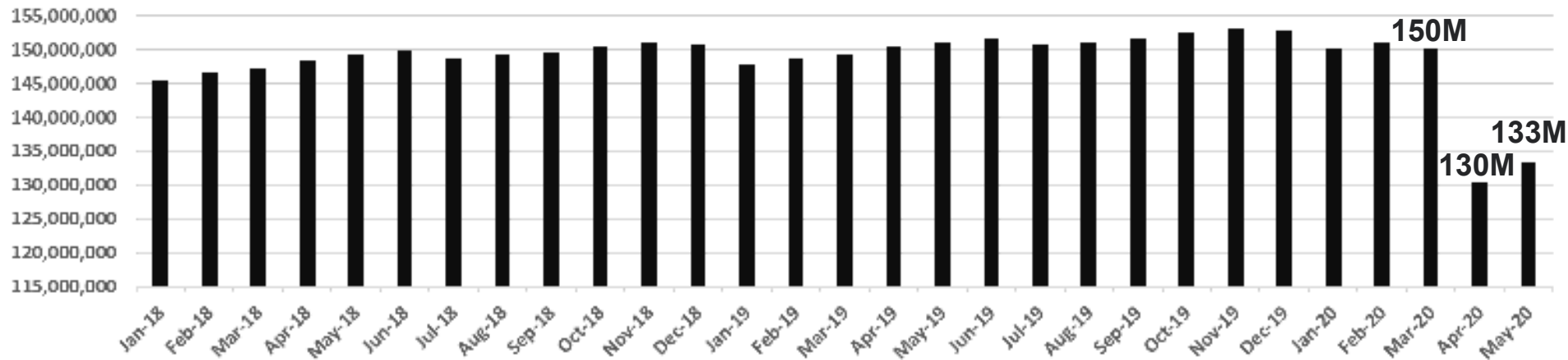

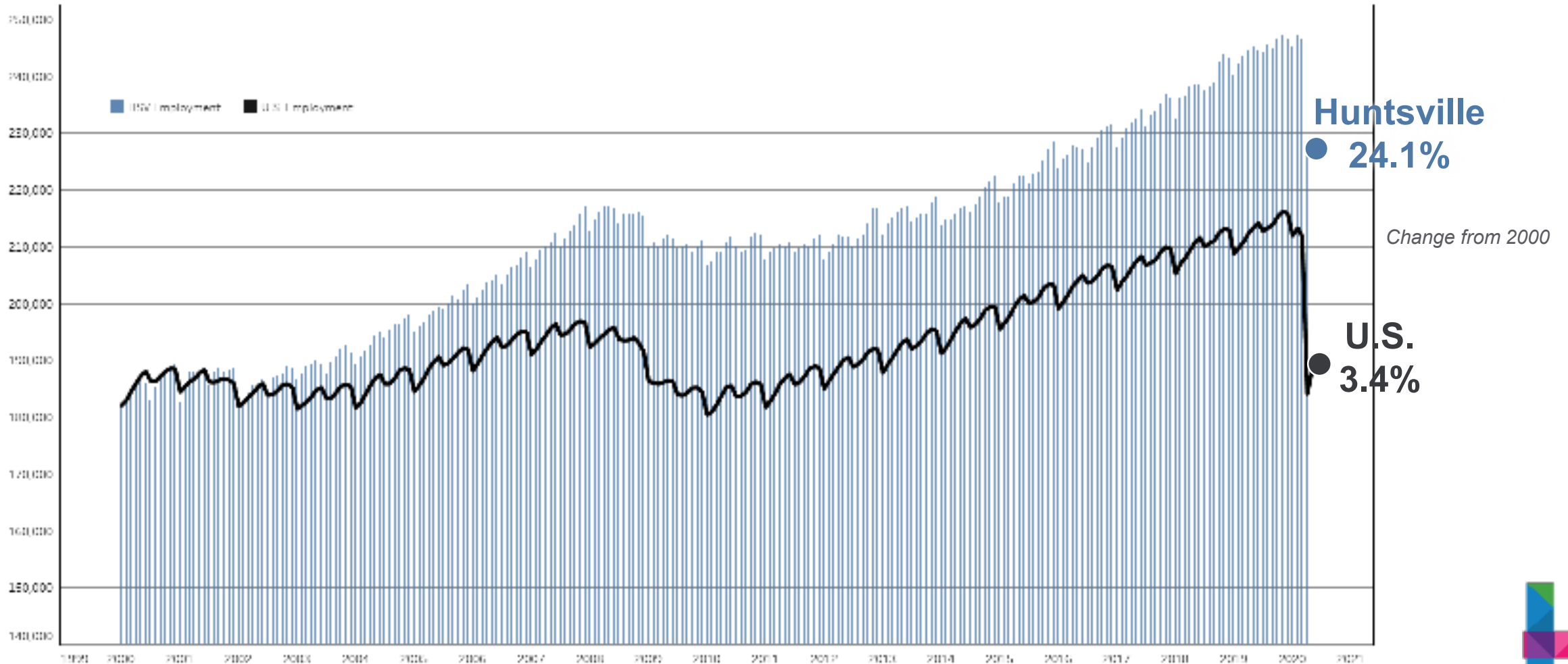

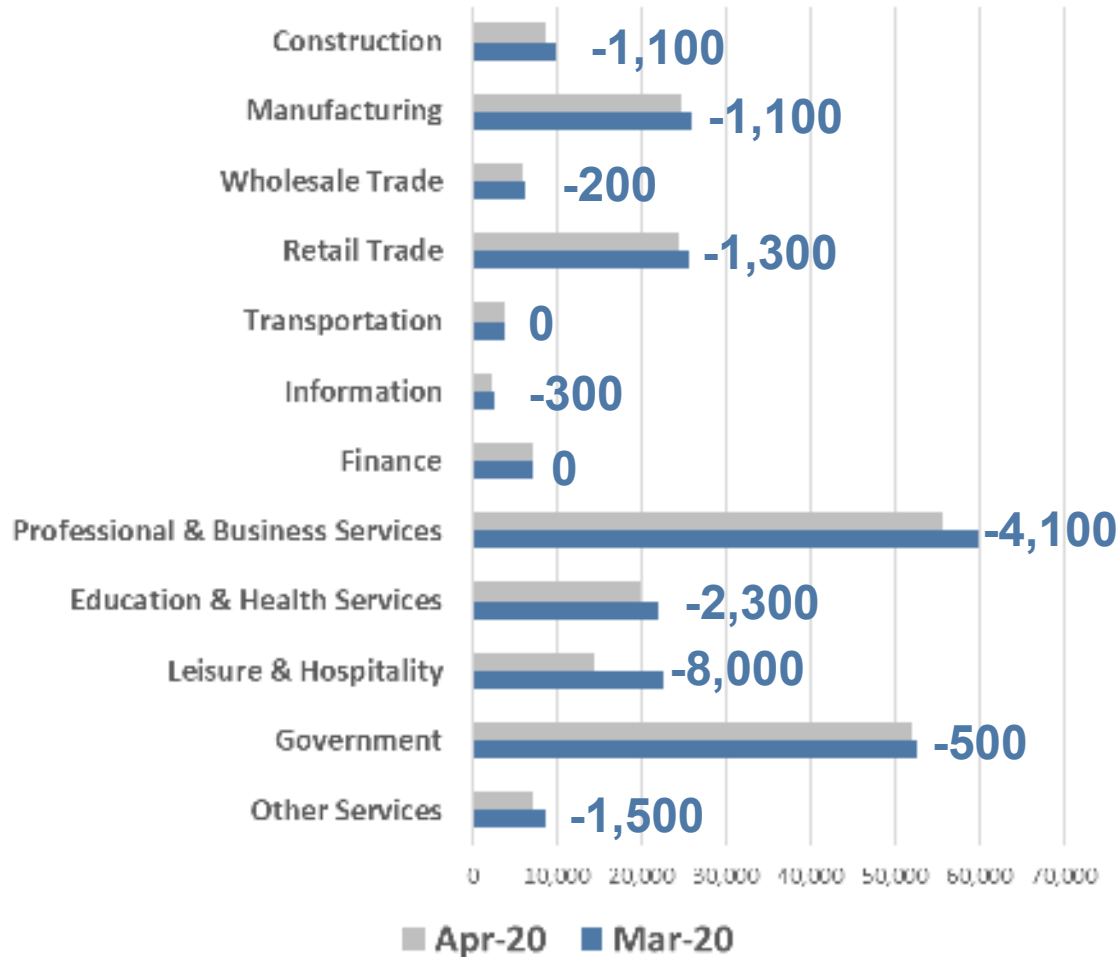
Employment Growth, 2000-Current



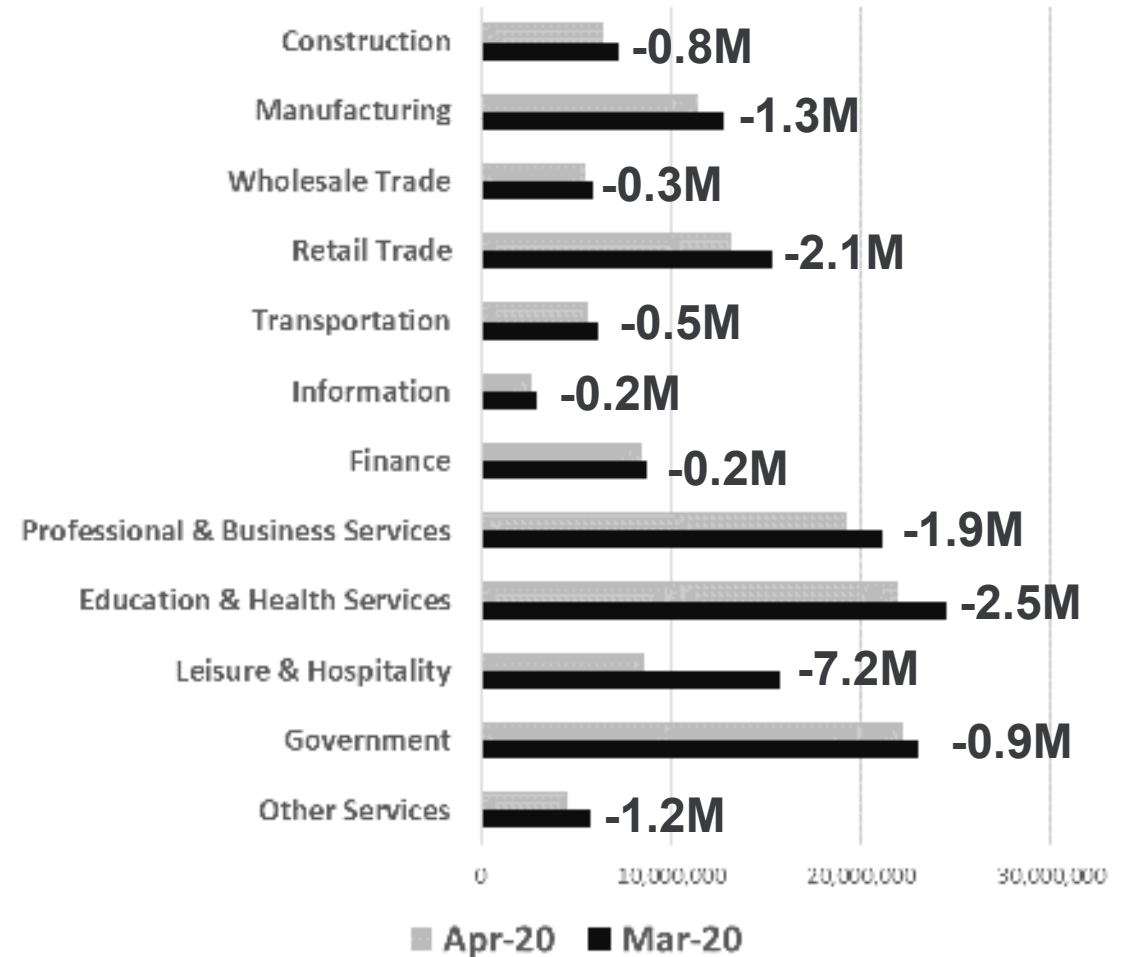

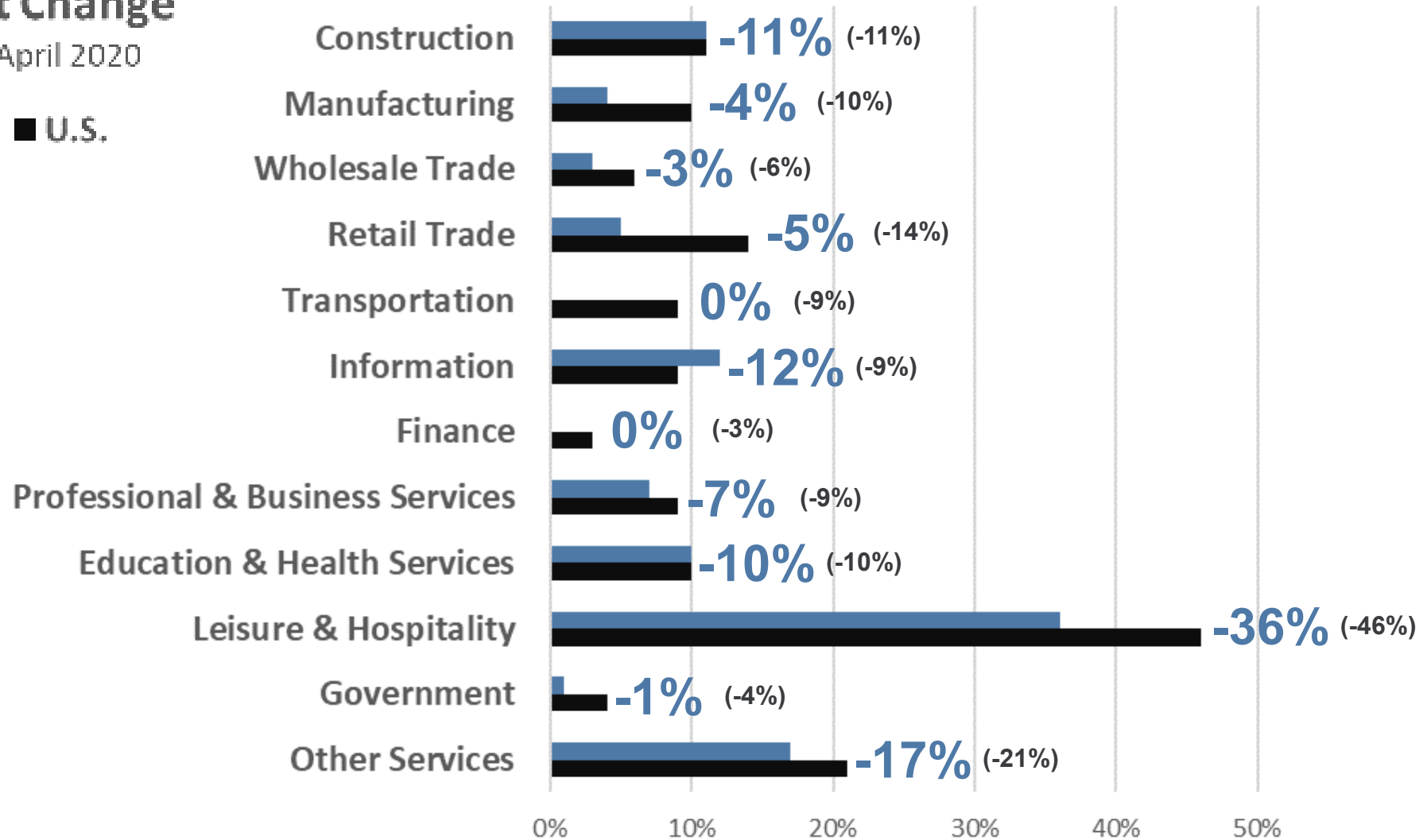

- Wage growth slow to pick up.

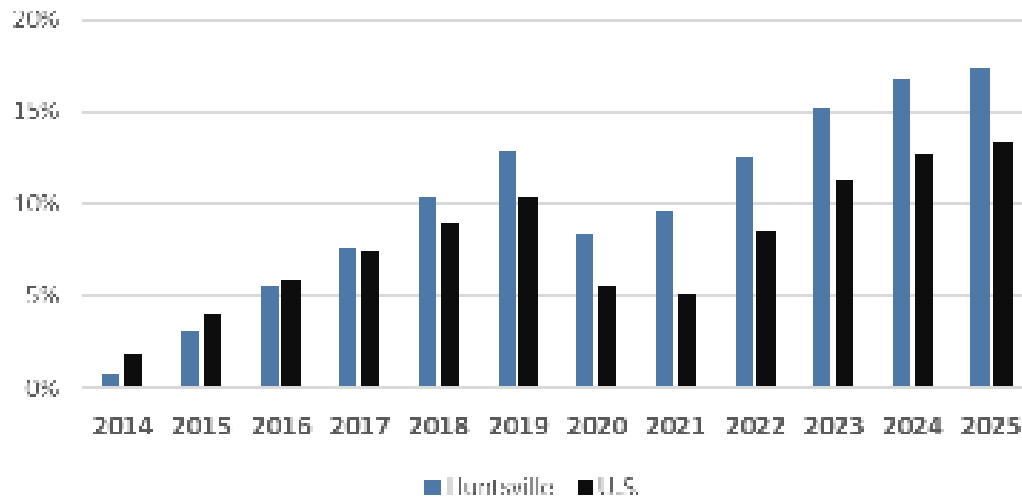

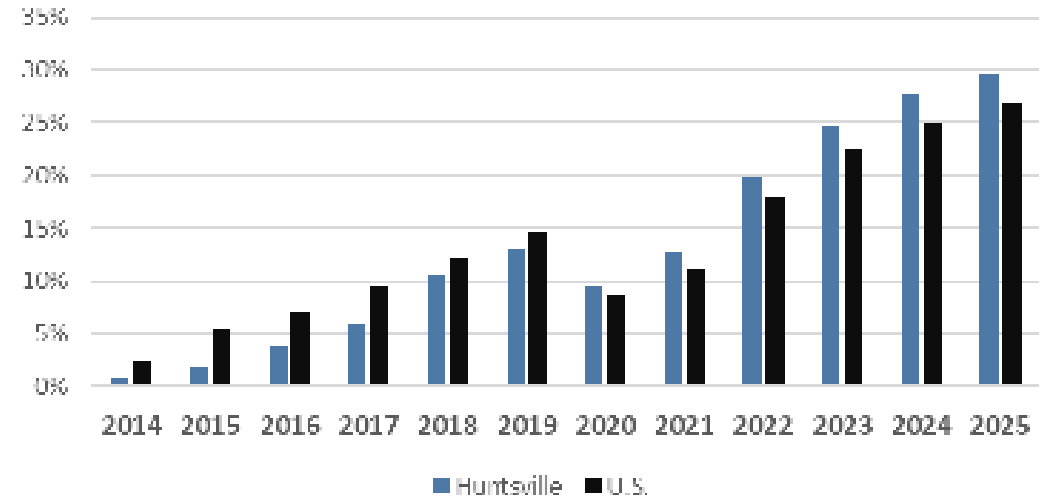
