- Leverage new technologies to achieve greater efficiencies

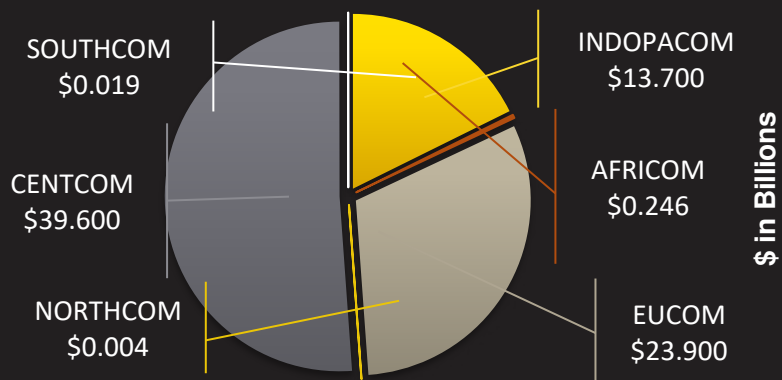

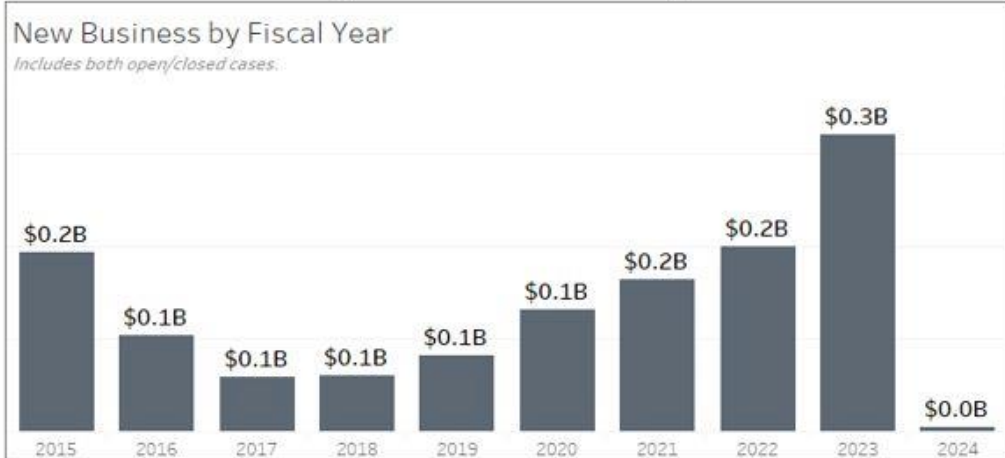

## **Army Contracting Command (ACC) Global Operations**

- ~6,000 Employees at over 100 Locations Worldwide
- 123,000+ Contracting Transactions Valued at \$92B in FY23

## **Current Contracting Operations in the Middle East**

- ACC currently has four BDEs and two centers involved in contingency planning efforts in support of the CENTCOM AOR.
- ACC forward deployed multiple teams throughout the CENTCOM/EUCOM AOR to provide business advice, requirement development and execution with its aligned partners. ACC remains responsive and flexible to enable force projection and combat power across the competition continuum.

## **Dedicated CENTCOM Support from 408th CSB**

- Approximately 1,000 actions valued at approximately \$125M in FY23
- Reach Back Support from ACC – Rock Island
