



# HOW...AND WHERE HNC WORKS




The **U.S. Army Engineering & Support Center Huntsville** (CEHNC) employs **942** Civilian Employees and Military personnel.

CEHNC supports **specialized missions** that require **unique technical expertise** in programs that are generally **national or very broad in scope**. The Center supports tasks not normally accomplished by a Headquarters U.S. Army Corps of Engineers element; tasks that require a centralized management structure, integrated facilities or systems that cross geographic division boundaries; and tasks that require commonality, standardization, multiple-site adaption or technology transfers.

Unlike the Corps' traditional geographically based organizations, the Center is not tied to water or other geographic boundaries. Instead, Huntsville Center is able to provide specialized support to all of the Corps' divisions and districts **throughout the world**.


